PRE-BID MEETING

An Informational Meeting was held at the ALCOSAN plant for the above project on May 31, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. in the O&M Auditorium. In attendance were David Borneman, Dan Lockard, Kim Kennedy, Jeff Mazza, Suzanne Thomas, Beth Ann Mellinger, Elizabeth Bowers, Marye Zoe Young and Alex Sciulli, the Owners Representative. In addition, Scott Cowburn of CDM Smith, the Clean Water Plan Program Director, was also present.

The Request for Qualifications was reviewed, and a brief Q&A session followed. Questions and answers presented at this meeting are as follows:

1. Does this project include the demolition of the hypo building?
 - a. Yes, the footprint of the new contact tank goes straight through the hypo building and storage tanks. The intention is to use the On-Call short list to re-establish the temporary hypo system for use in conjunction with the demolition of the hypo building.
2. Would ARCADIS be obtaining the permits that will be needed or will that be part of the designing?
 - a. Yes Arcadis will be submitting the Part 2 and joint application for the river wall. We do not foresee a change in your design, but if that would happen an amendment to the Part 2 would need to be submitted. Possibly a Part 2 for CSO would need to be submitted. We do not expect permitting to be a big part of this design project.
3. In the RFQ you request 5 case histories, however, there are multiple projects under this procurement. Can we add more case histories?
 - a. Consultants may include up to 8 case histories. The case histories must comply with Section C, "Firms Experience" in the RFQ.
