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**ADDENDUM NO. 2**

**A. Contract Documents**

1. Section 01010 Summary of Work

A. Paragraph 1.2 A 3 7 (page 01010-3) :

Replace the existing sentence that begins with “Install a complete insulation system...” with the following: *“Install a complete insulation system (with metallic jacketing, painting, labeling, directional arrows, etc.) to the new deaerator and all piping larger than 1” located within the deaerator penthouse. This pertains to both new and existing piping – whether currently insulated or not. If existing piping is currently insulated, the contractor shall remove all of the existing insulation, jacketing, etc. If said piping bears rust on its surface, the contractor shall lightly sand the loose rust prior to installing new insulation. All piping insulated under this project shall also have their valves, appurtenant items, fittings, connections, etc. insulated as well. [This also includes approximately 20 feet of currently uninsulated condensate piping located underneath the deaerator penthouse. This piping is at least 15 feet above the floor below, which houses our three boiler feedwater pumps. (Field-verify the details of this piping and its location.)]”*

B. Paragraph 1.2 A 3 10 (page 01010-4) :

Replace the existing sentence that begins with “Replace all ferrous drain pipes ...” with the following: *“Replace all ferrous drain pipes that discharge into this bowl (back to the first isolation valve or first union) in kind. Exceptions: The drain line from the large PSV on the inlet steam*

*line – replace the last 2 feet in kind. The drain line from the small PRV on the deaerator – replace the last 7.5 feet in kind.”*

C. Paragraph 1.2 A 3 11 (page 01010-4) :

*At the end of paragraph 11, add the following: “Replace the existing 1 inch ferrous sample pipe & ball valve, from the fitting on the west end of the deaerator to the connection with the stainless-steel sample tubing (approximately five feet). The ball valve is the same style as the isolation valves on the sight glass. (See add. # 1) Field-verify this valve (and **any/all** equipment/materials in this contract) prior to ordering”*

## **B. Questions**

1. Question: *“Does this bid require gas detection of any type?”*

Answer: The performance of the work may require gas monitoring, as the deaerator is a permit-required confined space. It is up to the successful bidder to identify and follow all applicable OSHA/industry requirements/guidelines.

## **C. General**

The modifications stated above shall apply to the entirety of the contract documents. If any original verbiage to the contrary still exists, it shall be deemed changed/modified as if included in the above specific citations.
